The CCVR Research Day provides an opportunity for CCVR laboratories to showcase their original research projects via poster and oral presentations. Abstract submission is now open for research posters, oral presentations, and awards for eligible trainees, at the 2013 Cardiovascular Research Center Research Day to be held on September 10, 2013.

To be eligible for consideration for one of the research awards, pre- and postdoctoral students must be the primarily responsible for their own original work, and must be sponsored by an identified CCVR faculty member. Posters or oral presentations prepared as part of a class project or already presented at conferences are welcome.

Research Presentation Awards:

Trainee-Investigator Awards: Three research award finalists will be selected from among all research trainee abstracts, by a CCVR faculty panel, for oral presentations at the symposium. (12 min presentation, 3 min Q&A.) A top finalist will be selected on the basis of the quality of their work, presentation and discussion, with runner up awards for the other two finalists.

Poster Awards: Posters will be judged by the CCVR panel for the top research presentation awards in each of the 3 trainee categories: pre-doctoral medical student, graduate student, postdoctoral fellow.

ABSTRACT GUIDELINES

- a. Presenter name and email address (plus trainee status, if applicable, for consideration for trainee research awards: medical student, graduate student, postdoctoral fellow).
- b. Name of CCVR faculty sponsor/mentor and his/her primary Department or CCVR program affiliation.
- c. Title and a list of author names and institutional affiliations.
- d. A 200 word limit abstract describing the research, to be sent as an attached Word document. (please, no embedded tables or figures).
- e. Please indicate if you would like your abstract considered for an oral presentation, or if you will present your work as poster only.

Please submit abstracts to odonnell@uic.edu by 5pm Friday August 23 2013 for inclusion in the program. Submissions not providing the information above (a thru e) will be returned.

Poster Specifications:

The poster must be no larger than 42”h x 56”w. Institutional affiliation should specifically include a line indicating the UIC Center for Cardiovascular Research. Please bring your poster to the presentation hall in the UIC Student Center West between 8:00 a.m. and 9:00 a.m. on September 10th to ensure your poster is set up for viewing throughout the morning session and judging that afternoon. Posters will remain on display until 3 pm. Box lunches will be provided to presenters and attendees during the poster session.

The 2012 CCVR Research Day is a wonderful opportunity to view and discuss the latest findings in cardiovascular science with students, fellows, and faculty. Topics include Heart Failure, Ischemia - Reperfusion, Proteomics, Cardiac Metabolism, Risk Assessment, Arrhythmias, Vascular Biology, E-C Coupling, Cardio-regeneration, Cardiac Arrest, and Pulmonary Hypertension, and Imaging.
